

These instructions are for the new Centos Linux systems.

at the 'dot' prompt:

prt

is a menu to easily execute each of the following commands

lpstat

displays the status of ALL of your printers

press [space] to page through, until you get back to the 'dot'

lpstat <lp####>

displays the status of a single printer

notice the small case. example: `lpstat lpt1`

lpstat -o

displays only print jobs that are queued.

lprm <job_number>

removes a print_job from the queue.

first, find the job_number using the lpstat command

example: `lprm 01234`

lprm -a <lp####>

removes all print_jobs that are queued to a specific printer.

example: `lprm -a lpt1`

lpmove <source> <destination>

moves all print jobs from one print queue to another.

example: `lpmove lpt1 lpt2`

pc

is a menu for re-printing
